NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that a public hearing will be held by the Town Board of the Town of Montgomery on December 5, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at Montgomery Town Hall regarding the petition of Medline Industries, Inc. to extend the water distribution system within the Montgomery Neelytown West Water District in the Town of Montgomery to include the lot designated on the Tax Map as Section 36 Block 1 Lot 35 located at 494 State Route 416 pursuant to the Order of the Montgomery Town Board Calling For Public Hearing Dated November 7, 2019, bounded and described in accordance with the Engineer's Report prepared by Kimley-Horn of New York, P.C. updated as of October, 2019. The petition and Engineering Report are now on file in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town, and

The maximum amount proposed to be expended for the improvements by the Town, as stated in the said petition, is zero (\$0,00) dollars, it being the intention that the entire cost of the improvements is to be paid by the Developer or its successor within the territory for which the extension of the district is proposed. The cost to the typical property owner to maintain the improvements will be based upon water use rates at no additional cost to be borne by the typical property owner.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY ALSO GIVEN** pursuant to Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law (State Environmental Quality Review Act/SEQRA) and its implementing regulations contained in NYCRR Part 617, the Applicant has prepared a full environmental assessment form ("EAF"), has completed a draft environmental impact statement ("DEIS") and final environmental impact statement ("FEIS") associated with the overall development action and the above proposed actions; and the Planning Board has classified this as a Type 1 action and has issued a positive declaration, has determined that it will act as Lead Agency for the purposes of SEQRA review.
