INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW – WAREHOUSE MORATORIUM EXTENSION**

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that a public hearing will be held by the Town Board of the Town of Montgomery on Thursday, April 15, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. at Montgomery Town Hall located at 110 Bracken Road, 2nd Floor, Montgomery, New York to review and consider the aforesaid Introductory Local Law.
