ROAD CLOSING NOTICE

**NEELYTOWN ROAD
(COUNTY ROAD 99)
TOWN OF MONTGOMERY
COUNTY OF ORANGE**

The undersigned Commissioner of Public Works of the County of Orange does hereby close all that portion of County Road 99 (Neelytown Rd.) in the Town of Montgomery, Orange County, New York. **BEGINNING** at a point approximately 0.6 miles east of the intersection of County Road 99 (Neelytown Rd.) and NYS Route 416 and runs **THENCE** in a easterly direction along said County Road 99 (Neelytown Rd.) approximately 250 feet (0.05 miles) for the purpose of allowing the Middletown and New Jersey Railroad, its agents or contractors, to excavate, repair, pave and do all such work as required in connection with the "Railroad Crossing Improvement of County Road 99" on said County Road. Said closing being effective by the conspicuous posting of "Road Closed" signs on or about November 18, 2019.

Said county road will be closed to all through traffic for a period of approximately Five (5) days in accordance with the provisions of Section 104 of the Highway Law. Appropriate traffic control devices, in accordance with the provisions of the National Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), and the New York State Supplement, will be in place and detour routes will be prominently marked. In the case of inclement weather or other unforeseen problems, this period of time may be extended as needed.

Normal through traffic using this portion of County Road 99 (Neelytown Rd.) should use alternate routes or signed detour routing that will utilize NYS Route 416, NYS Route 207, County Road 4 (Maybrook Rd.) and NYS Route 208.

Detour Directions for CR. 99 (Neelytown Road), Town of Montgomery:

Traveling South on N.Y.S. Route 416:

1. At the intersection of NYS Route 416 and County Road 99 (Neelytown Rd.) continue straight on NYS Route 416 and for approximately 3.2 miles to the intersection of NYS Route 416 and NYS Route 207;
2. Turn left onto NYS Route 207 and proceed east for approximately 0.9 miles to the intersection of NYS Route 207 and County Road 4 (Maybrook Rd.);
3. Turn left onto County Road 4 (Maybrook Rd.) and proceed northeasterly for approximately 2.6 miles to the intersection of County Road 4 (Maybrook Rd.) and NYS Route 208;
4. Turn left onto NYS Route 208 and proceed north for approximately 2.4 miles to the intersection of NYS Route 208 and County Road 99 (Neelytown Rd.).

(End of Detour)

Traveling South on N.Y.S. Route 208:

1. At the intersection of NYS Route 208 and County Road 99 (Neelytown Rd.) continue straight on NYS Route 208 for approximately 2.4 miles to the intersection of NYS Route 208 and County Road 4 (Maybrook Rd.);
2. Turn right onto County Road 4 (Maybrook Rd.) and proceed southwesterly for approximately 2.6 miles to the intersection of County Road 4 (Maybrook Rd.) and NYS Route 207;
3. Turn right onto NYS Route 207 and proceed west for approximately 0.9 miles to the intersection of NYS Route 207 and NYS Route 416;
4. Turn right onto NYS Route 416 and proceed north for approximately 3.2 miles to the intersection of NYS Route 416 and County Road 99 (Neelytown Rd.).

(End of Detour)

Traveling North on N.Y.S. Route 207:

1. At the intersection of NYS Route 207 and NYS Route 416 bear right and continue north on NYS Route 207 for approximately 0.9 miles to the intersection of NYS Route 207 and County Road 4 (Maybrook Rd.);
3. Turn left onto County Road 4 (Maybrook Rd.) and proceed northeasterly for approximately 2.6 miles to the intersection of County Road 4 (Maybrook Rd.) and NYS Route 208;
4. Turn left onto NYS Route 208 and proceed north for approximately 2.4 miles to the intersection of NYS Route 208 and County Road 99 (Neelytown Rd.).
